This includes interactive workshops, scenario planning, and prototyping exercises that clarify the opportunity at hand and stimulate innovative and more imaginative solutions. By doing so, we ensure that participants leave with a clear and actionable roadmap, and the confidence to implement strategic initiatives effectively.


#### **Design Office Hours**
